

Story & Pedigree of: FC Indian Hills Majer

Before we get to **FC Indian Hills Majer**, "*Midwest Beagle Gundog Association Hall of Fame & Better Beagling Magazine's Sire of the Year in 1989*", we must first start with the interesting turn of events that led up to him, the story of his Sire; Little Rowdy VI.

On Sept 17, 1970, a litter of beagle puppies was born at the home of Eugene Wells in Xenia, Ohio. The sire of the litter was **Playfair Cadet**, who was a show bred dog from the Dayton area, and the dam was Eugene's favorite gun hunting hound, **Well's Vickey**. Vickey was mostly old cottontail bloodlines, with also some show blood, but not to the extent of Cadet. Cadet came from a line called "Showfield", owned by a man named Mr. Wade from Dayton, OH. Other "Showfield" bred hounds included Ch. Rob-Ida's George With A J, who holds the distinction of being the last show champion to Sire a field champion, "FC New City Cruiser". In this approximately 3/4 show & 1/4 field breeding, within the litter was a black and tan male that became Little Rowdy VI. Until 1974, Rowdy was used as a personal hunting dog. But on April 4, 1974, an F-5 tornado hit the town of Xenia, OH. As a result of the damage to his owner's home, Rowdy changed owners and spent the next 6 years as a family pet. **Rowdy's Pedigree:**

In 1980 Larry Carter, of Middletown, Ohio, was able to acquire Rowdy. There were 2 litters sired by Little Rowdy VI after Mr. Carter acquired him, one being by John New. Mr. New bred his gundog field & show winner "New City Crystal" to Rowdy, producing FC Indian Hills Majer, New City Wannamaker and FC New City Pearl. **Crystal's Pedigree:**

Mr. New selected Pearl to carry on his breeding program, and sold Majer to **R.B. Sester** of Kentucky. Mr. Sester, **who was inducted into The Midwest Beagle Gundog Association Hall of Fame**, raised and campaigned Majer in the AKC Field Trials with great success. Mr. Sester finished Majer in the field and offered him at stud to the public and made several crosses himself. Indian Hills Majer was bred over 50 times producing many fine hunting & show dogs, depending if he was bred back to his "show blood" descent or his "gun dog" descent, but in either direction, **FC Indian Hills Majer** proved to be a powerful reproducer; *FC Miss Arkansas Traveler, FC Indian Hills Rowdy, FC Craft's Country DoLittle, FC Riley's Macon Ridge Tipper, FC Madonna Sawyer, FC Indian Hills Fred, FC Steppy B T, FC Fausts Bob BR, FC Indian Hills Spidean, FC Henry's Majerette, FC Majer's Turbo Bill, FC New Country's Mindy, FC Speedy Polly, FC Fausts Majerette, FC Brubeck's Singing Sally, FC Line Blazer Ace...* Just to name a few that finished in the field, out of different females, who had different trainers and handlers, under different judges from all around different parts of the country and they all only had two things in common; all were "Sired" by **FC Indian Hills Majer** and they all made Field Champion. Again, this was just naming a few. Mr. R.B. Sester not only finished a great Field Champion, he also established and provided the foundation for many kennels in the "beagle community". His contribution to countless Beagles, Gun Hunters and Field Trialers is immeasurable.

One "key" breeding that would later have a huge impact on our kennel "Laneline Beagles", came by way of Mr. Fred Faust. Mr. Faust bred a female by the name of **Donna Ray Macrae** to **FC Indian Hills Majer**. Donna was directly out of **FC Dingus Macrae & Gibson's Hustling Peggy Jane**. Dingus went back to Huntmaster, Toastmaster, Zion Pete, Dagwood's Ladaan and a lot of Fish Creek breeding and when traced further back, he derived mostly from Yellow Creek.

This cross of FC Indian Hills Majer & Gibson's Hustling Peggy Jane would produce two dogs that you will see throughout every pedigree in the Kennel of Laneline Beagles. Those two dogs are; **Deep Creek Jake** and **FC Mill Branch Major**. Eventually, Deep Creek Jake was acquired by Mr. Larry Perry, an avid gun hunter of Branchland, WV, who is known as an advocate of having intense demands and expectations for his hounds to have extreme hunt, grit and desire. Mr. Perry was already a line-breeder of the Dingus Macrae line and Jake became the backbone of his line. Laneline acquired Perry's Jake Jr. from Mr. Perry along with several others that are vital contributors to our kennel. Mr. Perry contributed to the enhancement of many Gun Hunters, Field Trialers and Kennels through Deep Creek Jake, Perry's Jake Jr. along with Perry's Sam, Perry's Randy, Cloverfield Ginger, Perry's Barney, Adkins Roxie, Perry's Spot and Perry's Peete.

As you can view from his pedigree below, Indian Hills Majer derived primarily from 3/8 "Show Blood", which is where he gets his looks from. The other 5/8 is mostly Cottontail breeding with some Hare breeding mixed in. The majority of the "Show Blood" crosses derived from hounds that were used in the AKC as "duel purpose hounds", meaning as much emphasis went towards the "appearance" of the beagle as to what the beagle could accomplish in the field, and a few were directly from the Show Ring. Some of the dogs used to evolve these hounds, were the same hounds that were used to evolve the pack of Mandy Bobbitt's Formal Pack "Bedlam Hounds", which Frank Reese incorporated into some of his Gay Kennel crosses with his Gay Baker descendents. This was done "steadily" in the AKC "Formal Pack" in the "early years" of beagling.

However, a push was made within the American Kennel Club among "beaglers in competition" towards a total separation of the "Show Beagle" and the "Hunting Beagle", so came a new movement. Gun Hunters that wanted to participate in Field Trials established Brace Trials, Small Pack Option Trials & Large Pack Trials. Several different Formats and Associations were formed. All of these "Trial Formats" were dedicated to the "hunting beagle" in the field, opposed to the Show Ring. Today, Formal Pack in the AKC is still pursuing the "dual purpose" beagle, attempting to harness both the "Show Ring Beagle" appearance and the aggressive hunt of a "Gun Hunting Beagle" combined into one complete hound.

Indian Hills Majer and his direct descendants were known for their Extreme drive, search, check ability and their "run to catch" style. Also, a very high percentage of the descendants were "off game proof" naturally.
